

## How to Report a Species Not Listed in the App!


## Open the application!









Tap on either

or All Species









... or swiping to the bottom of All Species will lead you to reporting options for species that are unknown or unlisted.

Input all information about the observation and include the name of the species observed in the Notes section. Save and then Upload the report as usual.



After uploading the report, you will receive an email (sent to the address you used to register an account with EDDMapS) with instructions on how to edit the species of your report.


