Reporting Results of Negative Surveys

What is a "Negative Survey?"


A Negative Survey documents a surveyed area that was evaluated for specific species and recording the species which were NOT found.

Why report a Negative Survey?


Without negative survey records, there is a degree of uncertainty of when the species actually spread to that area. Was this the first year that it spread to this area? Has it been there for years and no one was looking for it? By recording efforts of evaluating an area for specific species, and not finding the species, negative surveys help to establish a more accurate timeline of species' invasion.

How to report a Negative Survey?

Negative surveys can be reported through the regionally-based invasive species reporting smartphone/tablet applications (http://apps.bugwood.org/apps/).





