




Foliar Treatment where Hardwoods are Present

3 - 5% Glyphosate w/Surfactant in Water
Blue Indicator Dye

Foliar Treatment where Hardwoods are Absent

3 - 5% Glyphosate w/Surfactant in Water
0.5 - 1% Imazapyr
Blue Indicator Dye

Fall (Oct – Nov)
