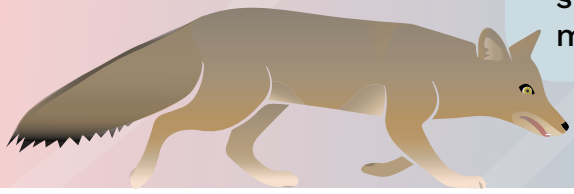


TERTIARY CONSUMERS

(apex predators, omnivores)



Canines eat mice, birds, snakes, insects, plant materials, fawns, carrion



Humans eat plant materials, deer, cows, milk, birds, fish, fungi

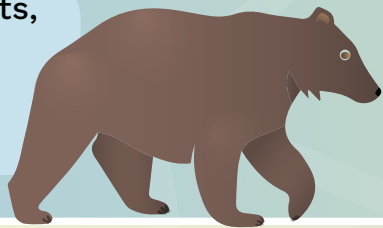


Raptors eat fish, rodents, birds, snakes, carrion

SECONDARY CONSUMERS

(carnivores, omnivores)

Bears eat rodents, insects, plant materials, fish, carrion



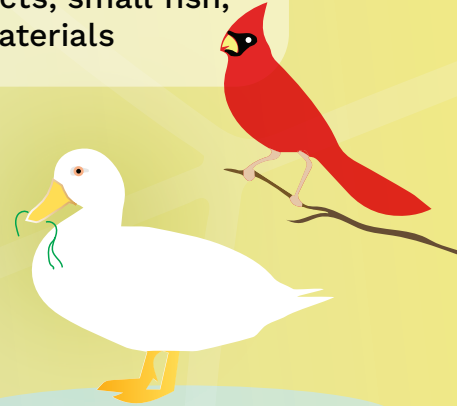
Fish eat plant materials, insects, other fish, water-dwelling animals



Reptiles eat rodents, insects, baby birds

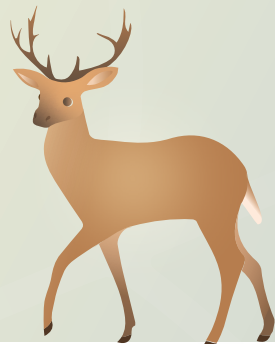
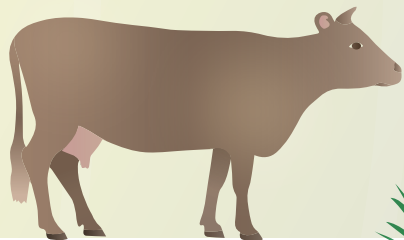


Songbirds and waterfowl eat insects, small fish, plant materials



PRIMARY CONSUMERS

(herbivores)



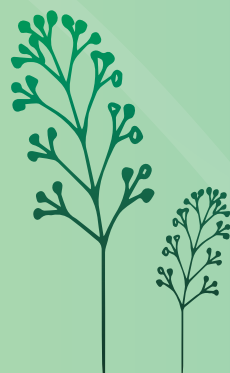
Insects eat plant materials, other insects, animals, carrion



Rodents eat insects, plant materials, fungi

PRIMARY PRODUCERS

(plants)



Plants make food (glucose) from carbon dioxide and water using the sun's energy, and release oxygen



DECOMPOSERS

(fungi, bacteria, protozoans, invertebrates)



Fungi help plants take up nutrients



Decomposers consume all dead plants and animals
