

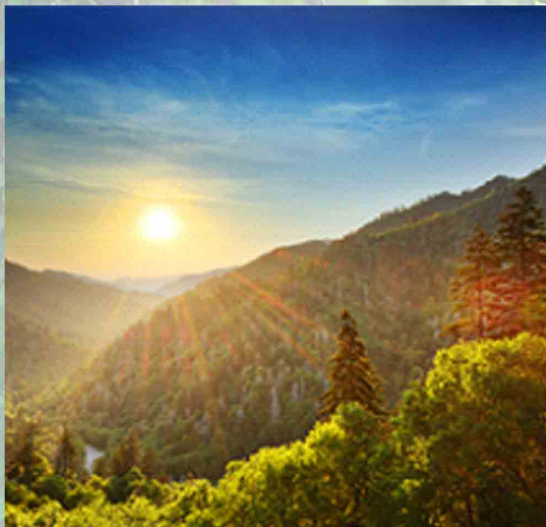
Become a Wild Spotter
